Interns are individually matched with a mentor and gain first-hand experience investigating the societal impacts of nanotechnology in a dynamic, collaborative research environment. Interns also attend weekly meetings, special seminars and develop presentation skills.

- **We will also provide up to \$900 for housing expenses**
