- II. Courses to be reviewed for GE placement should we review now or put on hold while we create SLOs?

The committee decided that it made no sense to keep reviewing and adding courses to the GE areas when we have yet to define what actually belongs in those areas. All GE placement will be on hold temporarily while SLOs are developed.

III. General Education SLOs

A. Accreditation Standard II.A.3. "The institution, relying on the expertise of its faculty, determines the appropriateness of each course for inclusion in the general education curriculum by examining the stated learning outcomes for the course."

B. Process for creating SLOs

Who needs to approve the SLOs we create? Curriculum Committee?
 The GE Committee will review the SLOs that are submitted by the faculty in each of the GE areas and will edit these SLOs, then present them to the Curriculum Committee for review. Finally, they will be presented to the Senate.

C. Process for Assessment of SLOs

1. How will we assess them?

We will use the course level SLO assessments for courses included in the areas. We will need to alternate sections and courses or it is overwhelming.
