XIV.	Distance Ed Committee report	I, D	The DE Committee met on December 1, 2016. Rainer Mack presented his hybrid ART R101 course in Canvas. Discussion took place on creating prerequisites for each module to prevent students from skipping around. He feels consistency is important in the layout of each module/week.
			The Distance Education Handbook was approved for First Reading, and will be presented to the Curriculum Committee in early Spring.
			Sharon Oxford, Instruction Technologist from VC, presented the OEI (Online Education Initiative) Readiness for Online Learning Program, a series of web-based tutorials to prep a student for online learning. VC, an OEI pilot college, requires students who wish to take an OEI course to complete an online course/self-assessment called Quest for Online Success. Quest is a series of videos and quizzes taken from the Readiness for Online Learning Program. The DE Committee in interested in including the Quest course/self-assessment for incoming students through SSSP, First Year Experience, a PG course, or Promise Pathway under the STEM Grant. The Curriculum Committee expressed support for OC to start a student course/self-assessment for hybrid and online courses similar to what VC uses.
			Dr. Cynthia Herrera, Lisa Hopper, and Janet Dawald presented Tableau as a visual data tool, which can be found on the OC website. Our college data is not disaggregated into hybrid vs. 100% online, which it needs to be. The committee requested the ability to see DE vs. Non-DE side by side in the same graph by discipline.
			A district-wide list of faculty members who have completed the Canvas and online instruction training is kept in SharePoint by the Instructional Technologists, and shared with all deans.
			Discussion took place regarding the recent article in the San Francisco Chronicle about City College of SF being required to repay \$39M to state over ten years because it can't prove that students received instruction in online classes. Our D2L and Canvas Learning Management Systems are set up to capture this type of critical data.
