XVII.	Distance Ed Committee report	I, D	The Distance Ed Committee met on April 7, 2016. A. Chelonis is recommending that our current DE instructors to take the pilot Canvas training in June. This summer the discussions will begin on how to make Canvas easy for students. The D2L contract ends June 2017. We plan to overlap Learning Management Systems (D2L and Canvas) in 2016-17. In the current pilot Canvas training, instructors who are new to online teaching may be lost, and instructors who are experienced may not receive enough Canvasspecific instruction. Therefore Ashley recommends waiting to take the Canvas training in June after she has revised it.
XVIII	General Ed Committee report	I, D	The General Ed Committee met on April 6, 2016. In addition to the approving a new course for GE and creating a new policy regarding honors versions of existing courses already approved for GE, the committee reviewed VC's and MC's latest GE approvals.
XIX.	LOT Committee report	I, D	The LOT Committee met on March 15, 2016. C. Mainzer shared that the last meeting is next Tuesday, April 19. There is a new PSLO Calendar for Fall 2016 to Spring 2018 that is due April 30. Up for discussion is 'distributed assessments' to move SLO assessment back toward a collaborative approach. The literature suggests 3-5 SLOs are sufficient for a course, and sometimes one or two are adequate depending on the discipline. SLO assessment discussion from faculty outside of the discipline is important too for a fresh viewpoint. Some faculty have expressed that it has been difficult to meet with adjuncts in single full-time faculty disciplines.
