XIII.	Review of Curriculum Deadlines	I	S. Davis shared the deadlines for courses. She will distribute the deadline calendars at the next meeting. New and substantially revised courses must come to First Reading by Oct. 7 to make the 2016-17 catalog. Courses with catalog and/or banner changes must come to First Reading by Nov. 11 to make the 2016-17 catalog. Shannon also explained that programs can be submitted on a rolling basis because, due to the delay in approvals at the state Chancellor's Office, there is no longer an expectation that programs submitted by a certain date will be approved in time for the following catalog. It is recommended that faculty submit programs as early as possible so that they can be sent in as soon as possible. It is also recommended that faculty not make constant minor changes to degrees and certificates each year and instead wait and make several changes at once.
