- I. Called to Order: By **President Kama'ila** at 2:10 pm
- II. Adoption of the Agenda: 1st **Robert Cabral** and 2nd **Tom Stough** *Motion carried unanimously*

III. Public Comment:

- A. Assistant Vice-Chancellor: **Dave Fuhrman** spoke about next steps for the new Course Management System (CMS). Dave says, "OC is lagging behind the other two colleges in making a decision." He told us that OC DE committee and the Curriculum committee approved the move to Canvas at their last meeting. Thus, it is now the AS Senate's turn to vote on the switch to Canvas. Some of the highlights from his comment include:
 - i. Not one person at any college has dissented.
 - ii. It will not cost anything to do this. It will actually save VCCCD approximately \$170,000 from Dave's budget and there will be some additional funding for switching to it. (i.e. there are some free tools that will be available)
 - iii. This summer some of the online classes will be offered using Canvas.
 - iv. D2L will go away at some point, but it should still be up and running for at least one year after the switch.
 - v. Contact **Mark Bowman** or our DE Committee for more information. He then answered some questions from Senators.
 - vi. We will need vote on this at the Senate meeting on March 28, 2016.

VII. Committee Reports

- A. PBC: (**President Kama'ila**): This committee was the first group to learn about the \$800,000 shortfall and next year's 1.8 million next shortfall for OC's budget. There were some state issues like no growth money and increased cost of health benefits and some district issues. **President Kama'ila** said there will not be any change to the instructional calendar/classes next year, but there also won't be growth. Some discussion about the OC Foundation's involvement took place and the district reserves.
- B. PEPC: (**Amy Edwards**) The PEPR review process is underway. Almost all of the PEPS are up on SharePoint. The committee will discuss these programs at their next meeting on Tuesday, March 29th.
- C. Accreditation is moving forward to the Board approval stage once it passes Senate.

VIII. AS President's Report

- A. Buildings:
- i. Condor Hall will not be online until at least fall 2016. There are two classrooms in there that only hold 30 students. Both rooms are set up with computers. These might be great for some English classes.
- ii. The Dental Building should be online soon. No one is committing to a date. The Dental program is being *very* patient.

- B. The President Hiring Forum is Tuesday, March 15th in the PAB at 4:30. Senate is hosting this event. There will be comment cards for the audience and they will go to the Chancellor. At the forum, **Ken Sherwood** will read the questions and **Amy Edwards** will introduce the candidates. We probably won't hear anything for about two weeks. Two Trustees that will be joining in on the final hiring committee are **Art Hernandez** and **Bernardo Perez**. The Senate expressed some concerns about the make-up of the final hiring committee.
- C. Curriculum: **President Kama'ila** spoke about doing some research on certificates available at other colleges that would be good for our college. For example, a Medical Information Technology certificate. We discussed some of our new curriculum such as the new AAT in Elementary Teacher Education. **Shannon Davis** will present to the Senate at an upcoming meeting about some of the changes that have taken place.
- IX. Treasurer's Report: **Tom Stough** reports that we have \$2,807.20. Dues monies will be added in over the next few weeks.

X. Discussion Items:

- A. Senate Release Time for next year: There will be an extra .2. **President Kama'ila** suggested giving that to someone as a "Curriculum Advocate" or something like that. If you have any other ideas, send to the AS President.
- B. Open Electronic Resources: Only one person answered **President Kamaila's** email. Please find this email and respond if you are interested. **Tom Stough** spoke about reserve materials and reserve readings for students.
