- II. Public Comment: None
- III. Announcements
 - A. **Tom Stough**: Café is now open for breakfast and lunch! 9:00am-1:00pm Monday-Friday. Lunch service will begin at 11:00am.
 - B. **Amy Edwards**: LTMS Event this Wednesday at 6:30. It will be an Actors Studio type event.
 - C. **Jose Vega**: Promote Transfer culture. We will be having a transfer fair next Tuesday, September 1 10:00am-1:00pm. Please send students.
- IV. Seating of New Senators
 - A. New Senators:

- B. Motion to seat new senators: 1st Amy Edwards 2nd Teresa Bonham: *Approved*.
- V. Approval of Minutes from May 11th: 1st Diane Eberhardy 2nd Teresa Bonham *Approved*
- VI. Treasurers Balance as of May 11, 2015: \$2,341.52
- VII. State of the Senate Report: **President Kamaila** reports and discusses:
 - A. Budget: The best budget we have had in years.
 - 1. We are now 27% of the district allocation model.
 - 2. We are back to the level of classified staff that we had before the layoffs.
 - 3. Several more adjuncts have been hired.
 - 4. We have about \$150,000 remaining and, so far, that money has not been tagged for anything yet.
 - 5. We have some Equity and #SP monies available.

- B. <u>Accreditation</u>: We are okay, but need to continue working on the writing. The first accreditation meeting will take place on Friday, September 4. If you are on a writing team, be prepared to get back to writing!
- C. <u>Buildings</u>: Discussion about buildings and location of counseling took place. Condor Hall will not be available until next summer. Hopefully the dental building will be open soon.
- D. <u>HR</u>: There are several situations/issues taking place:
 - 1. All management positions are now filled.
 - 2. District HR is very slow and there are a few issues.
 - 3. We should be looking for a Chancellor. We hope this announcement goes out soon because not having a Chancellor means we may not have a President on time either.
 - 4. Senators were concerned that districts seems to be appointing Interim Managers without a process at the district level and some senators would like to see all three senates come together to make a known objection to the Board. **President Kamaila** said she will bring it to an AS President's meeting.
 - 5. Overall, the Senate discussed the necessity to document the processes that were not followed so we have explicit documentation.

E. ASG:

- 1. Issues with elected officers. They have an interim President.
- 2. Please faculty, send student leaders and/or names of students to Linda Webb.

F. FON:

- 1. The FON went up, so we will, most likely, be hiring more full-time faculty.
- 2. We are hoping for 7-8 brand new positions, not just retirement replacements.
- G. <u>SAFE ZONE</u>: People are now trained in LGTQ issues/concerns making their areas safe zones.
- H. <u>Upcoming Diversity Training</u>: If you did it last year, you do not need to do it again. If you haven't, you need to do it this year in order to sit on hiring committees.
- I. <u>Communication Counsel</u>: This is not working as it stands in the PG manual, so it will be altering it to the First Fridays Chair/Accreditation meetings.
- J. <u>Removing "EVP"</u> from PG manual and changing it to the specific VP that will be chair that committee.
- K. **Art Sanford** will be <u>Interim Dean of Liberal Studies</u>. His background is originally in Spanish. He has been most recently acting 100% as VC's Accreditation Writer.

VIII. Department and Division Representation in Senate and on Committees

A. **President Kamaila** asked **President Limbaugh** if we can we increase faculty membership on PBC because we have a new division? No answer given yet.

- B. The changes to the Senators are relatively minor. One additional Senator with the addition of Transitional Studies department.
- C. 2.5 new department chairs: **Marnie Melendez** is now chair for counseling. **Mati Sanchez** is Transitional Studies chair. **Elissa Caruth** will chair Letters for spring while **Jim Merrill** is on sabbatical.

 - President Kamaila reviewed these AP/BPs and the Senate discussed some of the concepts. Senators also asked questions which were answered by President Kamaila and VP Sherwood, who arrived during this discussion.
