Students completing this Addictive Disorders program will have the necessary educational and skills requirements to apply for certification through the California Association of Alcohol/Drug Educators (CAADE). Students completing the Addictive Disorders Studies in the Criminal Justice System will be qualified to apply for CATC and FACT certifications

Oxnard’s Alcohol and Drug Counselor Studies prepares those who have completed the Addictive Disorders Studies Program. This advanced certificate program trains students to work as clinical supervisors, domestic violence facilitators, addiction and trauma counselors, program managers and prevention specialists.
