The attached table includes the 572 occupations that were included in the State of California's Labor Market Information (LMI) forecast of demand occupations within the county of Ventura for the ten-year period of 2008-2018. Please be reminded when using the provided data that there are typically several occupational listings that can be linked to a given Taxonomy of Program (TOP) code. The TOP code being examined should be compared to occupations in terms of skill sets and not the noted classification. In addition, included is also a listing 102 New and Emerging Occupations provided by O*NET (Department of labor/DOL website) which will provide you with an overview of what the DOL foresees for the immediate future in terms of emerging occupations.

The attached data is useful when conducting Program Review. The demand status of the noted occupations can help the planner to validate new and/or proposed curriculum
