The CSU general education breadth pattern requires each student to complete a minimum of 39 semester units (58 qtr. units) to qualify for full certification at the community college. Completion and certification of the CSU GE-breadth\* pattern will satisfy the lower division general education requirements of most CSU campuses, but CSU GE is not appropriate for every major/college within the CSU. Check with your counselor for updated information and always check on [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) before registering for classes. A grade of "C" or better is required to fulfill areas **A1, A2, A3, and B4 (known as The Golden Four)**.
