<p>Body & Fender Repair</p> <p>Body and fender repair technicians repair and refinish automotive vehicles bodies and straighten vehicle frames. They restore, refinish and replace vehicle bodies and frames, and window glass.</p>	\$18.68/hr.-\$38,850	50,100	+8-14%
<p>First Line Repairer Supervisor</p> <p>Directly supervises and coordinates the activities of auto body repair. Inspect, test and measure completed work, using devices such as hand tools or gauges to verify conformance to standards or repair requirements. Most supervisor positions require an associate's degree, training in vocational schools, or related on-the-job experience.</p>	\$29.43/hr.-\$61,220	152,000	+8-14%
<p>Auto Body Painter</p> <p>Auto body painters review damage reports and work with supervisor to plan work to be performed. They sand body areas to be painted and cover bumpers, windows and trim with masking tape or paper to protect them from the paint. Prime and paint repaired surfaces, using motorized sanders and spray guns.</p>	\$18.12/hr.-\$37,680	172,200	+13%
