From July 10 through July 14, Oxnard College's HSI Title V Grant collaborated with Cal Lutheran University TRIO Program to host the Oxnard College STEM Summer Academy. The program introduced thirty middle school students from Blackstock, E.O. Green and Ocean View to a variety of concepts found in Engineering, Physics, English and Mathematics with the help of Professors Justin Miller, Hussein Fahs, and Jose Maldonado. The program's projects emphasized teamwork, problem solving, critical thinking, planning, English and Mathematics fundamentals.
