- I. Called to Order by AS President Linda Kama'ila at 2:10
- II. Agenda Adoption: 1st Armine Derdiarian 2nd Amy Edwards
 - a. Changes to the order of meeting were made.
 - b. Motion Carried.

III. Public Comments:

A. ASG Interim President, **Josh Ruiz**, gave a report from the ASG Cesar Chavez event from last Sunday, April 12, 2015. The event was very successful and made a great impact on the community.

IV. Announcements:

A. Linda Kama'ila:

- 1. Proposal to have Dental Hygiene as a B.A. program was mailed out yesterday. It is on its way to the state-level at this time.
- 2. Multi-Cultural Day is this Wednesday, April 15, 2015
- 3. **Dr. Duran's** Farewell Party is April 24th at 5:30.
- B. **Robert Cabral** reports that he is on the B.A. Task Force at the State-Level. ("Thanks Robert for your participation at Plenary!")
- C. **Amy Edwards**: Theatre Club Comedy Show is May 1st 8:00pm. Please support the club students!
- D. New Transitional Studies Department:
 - 1. **Bret Black** expressed disapproval of this departmental change for the Math department on campus. Math put a proposal together of items that didn't work for them. Math also had live meetings with the college President, **Dr. Duran** during the fall 2014 semester. **Dr. Duran** seemed to agree at the time of their meetings. Math is not pleased that the proposal was completely ignored. Math isn't sure if the President didn't understand the proposal or just ignored it? They think, as a result, the department will take a complete step back. They like the idea of the new division, but they want it to work from the start and they do not think this will work as it stands. For example, Bret claims there are issues with scheduling and tenure. Thus, these details seem to have been ignored. Math is going to work toward overturning this decision. Please note that they were opposed right away. Senators asked if Math could forward the proposal to the Senators. **Bret Black** will ask Math if that is okay.
 - 2. AFT was also against this new department, said **Everardo Rivera**. He asked the Senate to come to the AFT meeting on Wednesday to discuss this issue.
 - 3. Discussion took place.
 - 4. **Teresa Bonham** added that English has the same complaints. English thinks there will be a bigger gap of student success. She also noted that she was surprised that more than two English people would be moving.
 - 5. More discussion took place.
- E. Evangeline Wilkes from the English department reported out on her recent conference:

- 1. She distributed handouts on a conference she attended called, National Association for Developmental Education (NADE).
- 2. She highlighted:
 - i. It's not just developmental although it started like that in 1976. It is also about professional development for educators.
 - ii. Their mission is to improve theory and practice of developmental education at all levels of the educational spectrum.
 - iii. She provided the history and facts of 2014.

 - 1. Technology: (Linda Kama'ila)

 - c. Discussion took place about the strengths and weaknesses of people leaving their posts.

2. DCAS: (Linda Kama'ila)

- a. We are still leading the growth in the district.
- b. Discussion took place about VC's reorganization and VC's new non-credit courses that are going to be offered at VC; no one knows how these will be funded.

3. AFT Report (Everardo Rivera)

- a. Asks us to be present from 3:00-4:00 for the tentative agreement this Wednesday, April 15, 2015. Refreshments will be provided.
- b. At the recent AFT Exec. meeting, they approved a new Dental plan, an HMO specific plan that may work well for some families. You will be able to enroll in this during open enrollment.
- c. Everardo is PRO "freezing the dues," but he got out-voted. He is pushing for dues to be frozen, although that may not happen. He is remaining vigilant on this issue.
- d. They had discussion about the transitional studies department and the large number of student grievances, recently. Everardo will be educated about the grievance process so he can be helpful when it happens.
- e. Some worries about the new hires and the amount of money spent on this. The district has spent about one million dollars to fund these hiring committees for administration specifically.
- f. AFT needs people for the re-opener team. Please respond to Steve Hall's email if you are interested.
