## STUDENT SERVICES AT OC

### ADMISSIONS AND RECORDS (A&R)

The A&R office is located on the first floor of the Student Services and Administration Building. A&R assists students with online registration information, transcripts, veteran's certification, and commencement.

### ASSESSMENT

New students taking general education courses are required to assess in Math and/or English. ESL placement and the Ability to Benefit (ATB) tests are also available.

### WELCOME CENTER

Student Ambassadors are available to assist students with their application for admission, student portal (MyVCCCD), registration, Agilegrad course planning, and general questions.
