


POPULATION

The population of Oxnard was estimated by the Census Bureau to be 184,463 residents as of July 1, 2006. That was an increase of .47 percent from a year earlier and an increase of 7.6 percent from the 2000 Census.

According to the 2000 Census, Oxnard's population was 170,358 residents, a 19.8 percent increase over the 142,216 residents in 1990. During the previous decade, the city's population increased by 31.4 percent from 108,195 residents in 1980.

FOREIGN-BORN POPULATION

The 2000 census recorded 62,902 foreign-born residents in Oxnard. That was a 36.9 percent share of the overall population, which was much higher than for the state (26.2%). The 2000 data showed an increase of 40.9 percent in the immigrant population since 1990, which compared with an increase of 10.1 percent in the native-born population (which includes children born to immigrants) over the same period. That meant that the increase in the immigrant population accounted directly for 64.9 percent of the overall increase in the population of the city.

In 2000, the Census recorded that more than one-third (37.4%) of the city's foreign-born population had entered since 1990. This was higher than the rate for the state overall (36.9%). About one-third (33.2%) of the foreign-born residents had become naturalized U.S. citizens. This was lower than the rate for the state overall (39.2%).

Another indicator of the impact of the foreign-born population may be seen in data on residents who speak a language other than English at home. In Oxnard in 2000, the share of other-than-English speakers at home (age 5 and older) was 62.1 percent. More than half (56.1%) of those persons admitted to speaking English less than very well.

In 1990 the city's foreign-born population numbered 44,636 and constituted almost one-third (31.4%) of the population. By comparison, the state's overall foreign-born share was 21.7%. Oxnard's 1990 immigrant population was the 32nd largest among the nation's cities.

POPULATION PROJECTION 2025

The current rate of population change between 1990-00, if continued, would result in a population in 2025 of 267,500. That is 57 percent larger than the 2000 population.

FOREIGN STUDENTS

The 2002/03 annual report of the Institute of International Education (IIE) shows the following foreign student post-secondary enrolment in schools in Oxnard: Oxnard C. - 129.
