TRANSFERRING or GRADUATING Soon!

Are you planning to Transfer and/or Graduate this year?

Below is a summary of the EOPS/CARE student responsibilities for upcoming Fall 2020 semester:

- 1. Notify your EOPS/CARE counselor and/or staff if you plan to apply for transfer this fall. You can submit your CSU admissions application starting October 1st, and can begin submitting your UC admissions application starting November 1st. (refer to Calendar of Events)
- 2. If you are completing your AA/AS degree and/or Certificate (IGETC/CSU GE) this fall, submit the application by *October 5th*.
- 3. If you will be applying for transfer to a CSU campus this fall, make sure you also apply to the EOPS Program. Any of our EOPS/CARE Counselors can serve as a reference.
- 4. The Writing Center is available for tutoring this semester. Including assistance with the Personal Statements needed to apply to the UC's. They are located in the Learning Resource Center (LRC) by the library and services will be available online via zoom at following link:

- 5. To make good use of your counseling services through EOPS/CARE, make sure to schedule at-least one phone counseling visit (minimum) per month with one of our EOPS counselors.
- 6. Check your MyVCCCD portal account regularly (at least once a week) for campus related information and upcoming Financial Aid deadline dates!
- 7. Finally, if your contact information (address, phone number) has changed, make sure you provide us with your information so that we can communicate with you.
