WHEREAS the Oxnard Academic Senate approved the OTTC curriculum for recertification last May, 2023, *without* reading the curriculum and *without* any discussion at all;

- WHEREAS the new CBA **requires** the Academic Senate to approve said curriculum, which is designed by the instructional technologists serving on each campus (per Section 23.4.A.) and such recertification process should **not proceed** until such curriculum has received the approval of the Academic Senate;
- WHEREAS the new CBA's requirement is that the recertification process take no more than **10** hours (Section 23.4.D.(3)a.);
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Oxnard College Academic Senate hereby **rescinds** its previous May 2023 approval of the OTTC curriculum;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any faculty member receiving a "Satisfactory" or "Excellent" in an on-cycle faculty evaluation (per Article 12 of the CBA) shall not be required to complete the recertification OTTC Recertification Course;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any faculty member receiving recent training (within the past two years) from another community college shall not be required to complete the OTTC Recertification Course; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any faculty member who "fails" the Recertification Course be allowed to appeal such decision to the Academic Senate for arbitration, should said faculty member feel that his/her/their recertification has been unreasonably withheld. Agreed to by the Oxnard College Academic Senate on September 11, 2023.
