Oxnard College holds a Wildland Academy every Spring:

- The spring academy begins the first day of the semester. Classes are held Wednesday and Friday beginning at 0800 and ending at 1700. This is a 16 week class that graduates near the end of April.

Prerequisites:

The following courses/requirements are prerequisites: completion required prior to application.

- EMT R109 or Higher Emergency Medical Responder Completion NO EXCEPTIONS
- FT R151 Fire Protection Organization Successful completion (C or better) (Academic Policies) MUST BE COMPLETED AT TIME OF APPLICATION.

GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION IS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THIS COURSE. Prior to the start of the academy, students will be required to go through a health, wellness, stamina, and strength screening which will be conducted by the college at a designated time and location.
