

# **Foster Youth Checklist**

## □ Step 1: Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act (CADAA) from *October 1<sup>st</sup>* -*March 2<sup>nd</sup>*

#### For U.S. Citizens or Permanent Legal Residents Only

- Create a FSA ID at: <u>https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/sign-in</u>
- Submit a FAFSA at: <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>
- List Oxnard College Federal School Code 016391
- Priority Deadline is March 2<sup>nd</sup>

#### For AB540/Undocumented Students Only

- Submit a CDAA at: <u>https://dream.csac.ca.gov/</u>
- List Oxnard College
- Priority Deadline is March 2<sup>nd</sup>

### □ Step 2: Submit a Chafee Grant Application

- Apply at <u>www.chafee.csac.ca.gov</u>
- Click on Start Chafee Application

#### Chafee Foster Youth Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a current or former foster youth who was a ward of the court, living in foster care, for at least one day between the ages of 16 and 18.
- If you are/were in Kin-GAP, a non-related legal guardianship, or were adopted, you are eligible only if you were a dependent or ward of the court, living in foster care, for at least one day between the ages of 16 and 18.
- Have not reached your 26th birthday as of July 1st of the award year.
- Have not participated in the program for more than 5 years (whether or not consecutive).
