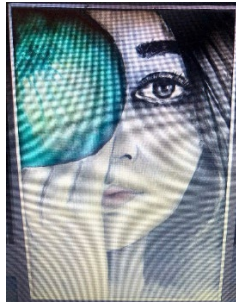

Cost: \$50.00



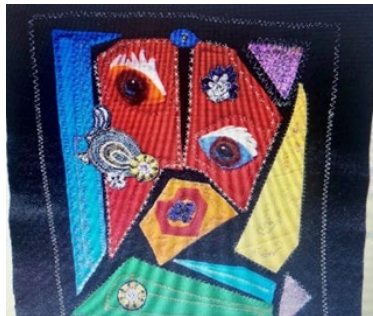

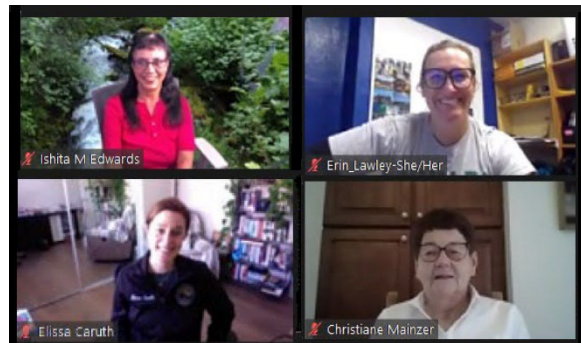
