Discussion:

Senate Treasurer Ishita Edwards: The way I see it is tracing the history of the % that used to be allocated to the board. They used to get 6.1% [and then it was increased] to 7% [and then increased] to 14.2% now they are asking for a further increase. I'm concerned about that. I have not seen efficiency from that increase. Also, when I looked at comparisons we had many more full-time faculty that's not a fair comparison. I don't believe the data that we have more FT faculty. Alan Hayashi: 10 years ago, the budget was 7.1% before they moved to Camarillo. We only have 3 Vice Chancellors, since that time it's been doubled that cost and staffing. The [workload is being] sent back to colleges [with] a lot of the responsibilities they took on. When they added the Vice Chancellor's position (and their support teams), including the latest Institutional Effectiveness, they did not ask the colleges and took it out of the budget. Along the way, they need to consider that. A couple of years ago in negotiations, they were looking at comparative salary of Chancellors they said they needed to raise the to over a quarter a million dollars otherwise we would not get a good candidate for the position.

Senate President Amy Edwards: I'm on the Chancellor's hiring committee.
