- Official College/University Transcripts:** Hard copy sealed official transcripts from ALL colleges/universities EVER attended. No electronic transcripts accepted.
- Evaluated Foreign Transcripts (if applicable):** A hard copy evaluation of foreign transcripts completed by one of the approved agencies that includes course titles in English, the U.S. semester equivalency, and the grades earned.
- Official Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Score Report (if applicable):** Official College Board AP score report if being used to satisfy the Written Communication and/or Mathematics prerequisites.
- CPR Certification:** Copy of current CPR Certification card from American Heart Association or American Red Cross course in Basic Life Support (BLS/CPR) with a live in-person skills component.

Failure to submit ALL the above items together will be considered an incomplete application packet and mean that you cannot be included in the lottery selection process.
All complete application packets must be delivered to the Dental Hygiene Department by the deadline, no exceptions.

- Biomedical Science GPA & Recency:** I understand that I must have and maintain a 3.0 biomedical science GPA (ANAT R101, CHEM R110, PHSO R101, MICR R100/MICR R100L, and CHEM R112) and that these courses must be completed within the past five years.
- Completed/ In Progress Courses:** I understand that I may only have at most the two following prerequisite courses in progress at the time of application: DH R001 and one biomedical science course (ANAT R101, CHEM R110, PHSO R101, MICR R100/MICR R100L, and CHEM R112) with its corresponding lab. I understand that all other prerequisite courses must be completed at the time of application.
- In Person/ Online Labs:** I understand that all labs for the biomedical science prerequisites (ANAT R101, CHEM R110, PHSO R101, MICR R100/MICR R100L, and CHEM R112) must either be completed by traditional, in-person wet labs or online using a lab kit in conjunction with faculty oversight and teaching.
