Fall and Spring Academy

Oxnard College holds two Regional Fire Academies per year:

- The fall academy begins the first day of the semester. Classes are held Monday thru Thursday beginning at 0700 and ending at 1700. This is a 17 week class that graduates mid-December.
- The spring academy begins the first day of the semester. Classes are held Monday thru Thursday beginning at 0700 and ending at 1700. This is a 17 week class that graduates near the end of April.

- **EMT R169 - Emergency Medical Technician .**
- **FT R151, FT R154, or equivalent** - Successful completion (C or better) (Academic Policies) **COMPLETION RECOMMENDED AT TIME OF APPLICATION.**
 - Any pre-requisites In-Progress will be viewed as “Last Up” for available seats

GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION IS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THIS COURSE. *Prior to the start of the academy, students will be required to go through a health, wellness, stamina, and strength screening which will be conducted by the college at a designated time and location. Spirometry testing will be required and provided by Oxnard College.*

Any course In-Progress will need to include a Progress Report with Current Grade from your instructor. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED AND RECEIVED BY THE LAST DAY OF FILING (open period) **BY 1500 (3pm)**. POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS A RECEIVE DATE.
