D. Amy's new Senate position/Impact on VPA - This new position will take Amy out of classroom for now, but allows her more time in office and to answer emails. Will stay on as VPA chair. VPA will need to have a senator to have a vote. Marcia would not mind being senate rep. (pull her from Student Success committee). Thank you

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- Marcia. Could Anitra take on Student Success if need be? More discussion needed on this.
- E. SLO reporting (full-time & part-time) – Our numbers are low across campus. We don't have to fill out questions anymore. Just do the scorecards. Put N/A after all questions if the questions do pop up. Adjunct faculty need to do SLO reporting also as part of their load. Lead faculty in specific areas will help adjunct faculty get ball rolling starting now. Need to report every semester at end of semester. A discussion about SLOs took place after discussing specific "to do" list items. We spoke about the goal of SLOs and the connection to student success. All 6 disciplines within VPA added information and questions were answered. There was agreement that VPA would focus on SLOs more over the next few semesters and continue to increase reporting.
- F. Program Review Report Updates (Marcia) – none of reviewer's rubrics on share point yet. We got all good reviews for all of them. They like the use of McNish, happy with enrollment, and commented on need for new space to affect success rates in good way. Film was excellent, thoughtful plan for growth, good retention and success rates, but need they need equipment, internships. Dance was rated good, strong presence in college community, talked about working with Gabby R./cinco de mayo and oc live; expanding dance with two new courses this spring, PE rooms need tech update and AC because it feels like NY in the 1980's in there. Theatre was ranked good, has strong enrollment, success and growing there is a demand. OC LIVE helps to grow program and design program for internships.
- G. Art Buildings Update (Rainer & Christine) – went to PBC meeting to present proposal. Emerged in PBC there are infrastructure funds for renovation. Worked with Chris Renbarger and Bob Sube to work with figures; 1.5 million to replace North Hall, South Hall and NH7. Also asking McNish to get a refresh. Rainer and Christine will be presenting at CUDS next Tuesday. Amy's students presented project regarding need for NH to be fixed, Pres. Sanchez commented that the college is working on it.
- H. Garden Issue Update (Christine) – M&O cleared back of McNish, waiting for Bob Sube to order materials for garden boxes. Amy will send email to check on timeline.
- I. Showcase for May 2020: Breaking Free – Faculty, please find talented students who would like to be involved. Keep in mind who you have THIS SEMESTER so we don't forget about them!
- II. Committee Reports

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- A. Senate: (Amy) Need new VPA Senator –Marcia was elected! Thank you. See you at the first senate meeting on January 13, 2020!
- B. PEPC: (Marcia) – See above
- C. PBC: (Rainer) – continuing to talk about membership and committee charge. LA-19 now has HVAC, and planning to move forward with each room having an AC unit. Additional state monies are coming to the colleges. We're expected to get half a million. PBC plans to look at last set of resources requests and see what they can fund. Art S. recommended we bolster budget for substitutes. Send Rainer an email if you want to bring something forward.
- D. CUDS: (Rainer) – There is a plot of land behind gym, next to tennis courts that President Sanchez would like ideas about what to do with it? (Agricultural program? Golf course?) Rainer will be sitting on a Facilities Master Plan task force and will keep us posted. Darlene Inda is pulling together a new signage initiative for the college. ART faculty agree on “Art + Design” for new buildings name.
- E. Curriculum: (Scott) - Can Scott ask about FTVE and Film class? Can we add MQ that theatre person can teach the class?
- F. DE, ITAC, DWEAC: (Scott) - each meeting will be at a different college, to look at different things, new gadgets. The big conversation is anyone who was Canvas certified, but haven't taught with it in 3 semesters, needs to be recertified. Needs to be recertification at all colleges. They are looking into this. OC is hosting the distance ed summit in the Spring 2020. If anyone is interested in teaching or doing break out session, let Scott know. March 19th (professional development day) is the date of the summit. Rainer brought up there are tech issues in the classroom. These things on the agenda, so people hear the tech issues so someone from IT can fix it. Scott will bring these issues to the committee.
- G. Library & Learning Resources: (Christine) – discussion on relocation of STEM to the library. Tom is still reviewing Primo VE system. The new VCCCD fulfillment “newtwork” has been extensively tested. We will be able to cross-lend and borrow physical books and other items beginning spring 2020.
