The college's goal is to help limit unnecessary units or courses while also providing broad career and major exploration for undecided students.

Learning and Career Pathways

Learning and career pathways are groups of careers that share common themes or require similar skills.



Hands-on Learning

The Hands-on Technology pathway provides a lot of applied learning, like building things with your hands or working in the ever-evolving world of computer networking. Skills developed include critical thinking, analyzing problems, and working with technology beyond the traditional office space. This pathway will lead to direct employment opportunities upon completion.

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Business & Hospitality

Business and Hospitality's pathway teaches the skills of leadership, creativity, entrepreneurship, and independence. All of which are skills and attributes used in careers like Finance, Marketing, and the Hospitality industry. This pathway will allow students to transfer, upgrade their current business skills, or enter the workforce immediately.

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Language & Literature

The Language and Literature pathway can provide an avenue to careers as an Interpreter, Middle and High School Teacher, Journalist and offers global opportunities. This area of interest may be a good fit if you like meeting new and diverse populations, learning about cultures, and want a more independent work environment.

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Law, Culture, & Society

The pathway of Law, Culture, and Society is the opportunity to impact society from multiple angles with a social justice perspective. If your goal is to help shape your community, this vital investigative pathway may be the key to a career in Law, Education, Public Policy, and Social Research.

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Public Safety, Health & Wellness

The Public Safety, Health, and Wellness pathway focuses on professions promoting a healthy and safe society. Programs prepare you for careers in the diverse helping industry and physically protecting the community. This path can lead to Registered Dietitians, Drug and Alcohol Counselors, Dental Hygienists, and Emergency Responders, to name a few.
