International students seeking enrollment must satisfy the following:

- An application process that includes submission of appropriate visa information from the country of residence, including USCIS forms.
- Students who will be attending pursuant to an F-1 visa will submit a bank statement, unofficial translated proof of high school completion or equivalent, and a copy of their passport to substantiate issuance by the District of form I-20.
- F-1 visa students are required to enroll in no less than 12 units (full-time) excluding summer term.
- Required test of English as a foreign language proficiency such as TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores, if applicable.
- Residence determination, including review of whether student holds a visa that requires the student have a residence outside of the U.S., or entered the U.S. under a visa that permits entry solely for a temporary purpose. Exemptions from nonresident tuition as authorized by Education Code Section 76140 subdivision (a)(2) for financial need.
