## Education Support for Faculty and Staff

Additionally, ITDs regularly research, test, and make recommendations for the inclusion of cutting-edge learning technologies meant to enhance equity and access to a variety of learning subjects in the education learning environment. ## Online Teaching

If you are planning to teach an **online or hybrid** course in the future for VCCCD, you must complete the district Online Teacher Training Course in Canvas *prior to assignment*.

Completion of the course prepares you to teach online for all three colleges in the district and effectively set up and manage your courses with the **most recent California Community College Chancellor's Office standards for distance education**. The training course is a four-week, online course to replicate the student experience.
