Reflects science and education from the American Heart Association Guidelines Update for CPR and Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC). Upon completion of all course requirements, participants are eligible to receive a BLS Provider Course Completion Card, which is valid for two years, (Cost: \$8). Please pre-purchase a BLS Provider Manual, \$18.50 or BLS Provider Manual e-book, \$15.80.</p>
