



Fire Academy Application

INTRODUCTION

Oxnard College holds two Regional Fire Academies per year:

- ➤ The fall academy begins the first day of the semester. Classes are held Monday thru Thursday beginning at 0615 and ending at 1720. This is a 18 week class that graduates mid-December.
- The spring academy begins the first day of the semester. Classes are held Monday thru Thursday beginning at 0615 and ending at 1720. This is a 18 week class that graduates early May.

Upon graduating, cadets will receive CSFM and NWCG certifications. For a complete list of certifications go to Fire Academy Certificates on www.oxnardcollege.edu/fire

PREREQUISITES:

Successful completion of the classes below is required prior to Fire Academy start date. Students who have completed all prerequisites at time of application are given first consideration. For more information, please visit our website.

- FT R151, FT R154, or equivalent Successful completion (C or better).
- **EMT R169 Emergency Medical Technician** A copy of the "Course Completion Record" must be submitted as proof of successful skills exam completion OR a copy of your EMT certification card through the state of California or NREMT. <u>The "Course Completion Record" or EMT card must be valid through the application process up to the completion of the academy.</u>

GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION IS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THIS COURSE. Prior to the start of the academy, students will be required to go through a health, wellness, stamina, and strength screening which will be conducted by the college at a designated time and location. Spirometry testing will be required and provided by Oxnard College.

ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES

Your placement in the Academy will be determined upon review of your application and support documents. All support documents must be in your application package for you to be considered for the Academy. Any course In-Progress will need to include a Progress Report with Current Grade from your instructor. Incomplete applications will be set aside and ranked last.

There are 40 seats open each semester for the academy. The 40 cadets are chosen based on successful completion of the pre-requisites.
