Welcome to summer and to this month's edition of our Classified Senate Newsletter.

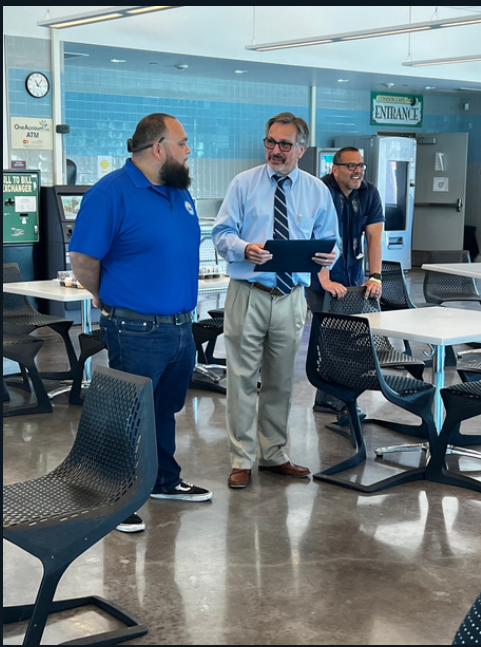
